

## Kinzua Outdoors Announces New Format for It's 2023 Season.

With May quickly approaching Kinzua Outdoors is excited to announce the new changes made for the 2023 season.

We have always prided ourselves in being a affordable grass roots circuit that is fun and affordable for all anglers regardless of experience level. In keeping with that tradition I believe we are still offering that same opportunity, even with costs of everything rising.

- Each event will be a minimum of 80% payback based on a \$200.00 Entry Fee. (includes Big fish pot)
- Big fish pot at each circuit event will be a minimum of \$ 25.00 per team entered (50 teams = \$1,250.00).
- Anglers need to declare at the beginning of season if they are interested in possibly qualifying for the Cabelas NTC Championship. All interested must join the TWF by the end of the first tournament (inform me).
- We will pay 5 places per event, breakdown percentage: 40, 20, 16, 13, 11 (may be rounded up or down)
- We will be awarding top 5 and big fish plaques.

We have eliminated the following:

- No T.O.Y. Pot, it will be paid out to winners at each event.
- No H.O.A Pot at Championship, we are not increasing the set entry fee.

We are eliminating the following plaques at the Championship to cut down on costs:

- 2<sup>nd</sup> - 5<sup>th</sup> place "high overall" plaques.
- Mixed couple "high overall" plaques.
- Guardian / youth "high overall" plaques

Over the past several years we have run these events with "NO" cash sponsorships.

There are several opportunities available for any one interested or any one knowing of any one that may be interested, all help is greatly appreciated!!!

- Kids fishing: August 13<sup>th</sup>
